Tommy Kha (b. Memphis, TN) is a photographer working between Brooklyn, New York, and Memphis, Tennessee. He holds an MFA in Photography from Yale University, where he currently teaches. Kha is a 2025 Guggenheim Fellow and a recipient of the Hayes Prize, Next Step Award, Foam Talent, Creator Labs Photo Fund, and an NYSCA/NYFA Artist Fellowship in Photography. His work has been featured in *The New York Times Magazine*, *Aperture*, *The New Yorker*, *Vanity Fair*, and other publications. He has had solo exhibitions at Higher Pictures, Baxter St at the Camera Club of New York, and Blue Sky Gallery. Kha's first major publication, *Half, Full, Quarter*, was published by *Aperture* in February 2023. He joined Higher Pictures in 2022, and currently studies kung fu under Sifu Ken Lo.
